**DENIS GAGNÉ CO-AUTHOR OF A SECTION IN
THE 2008 BPM AND WORKFLOW HANDBOOK**

MONTREAL, September 4, 2008 – Denis Gagné, CEO & CTO at Trisotech, co-authored with Dr. André Trudel from Acadia University, a section of the **2008 BPM and Workflow Handbook**.

The section, entitled “**The Temporal Perspective: Expressing Temporal Constraints and Dependencies in Process Models**”, provides 31 temporal constructs that may occur when defining a process model.

The characterization of these temporal constraints provides a basis and objective means to evaluate the temporal expressiveness of various formalisms and tools. A discussion of the suitability of BPMN (Business Process Modeling Notation) and Gantt Charts for business process modeling from the temporal perspective is also covered.

The **2008 BPM and Workflow Handbook** regroups articles on methods, concepts, case studies and standards in Business Process Management and Workflow. It is published in association with the Workflow Management Coalition (WfMC).
